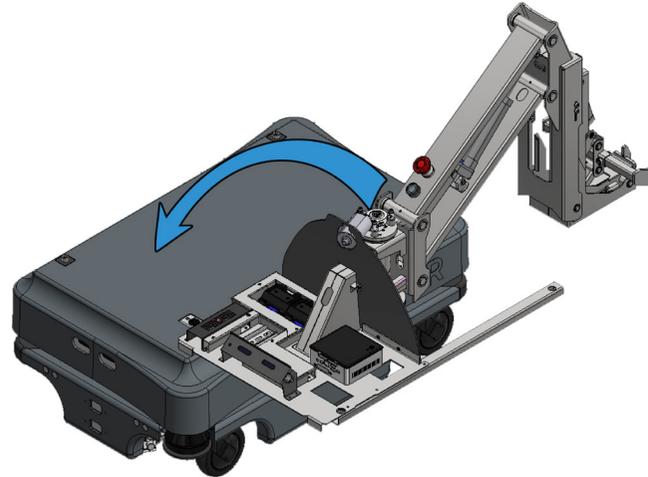

MiR200 robot



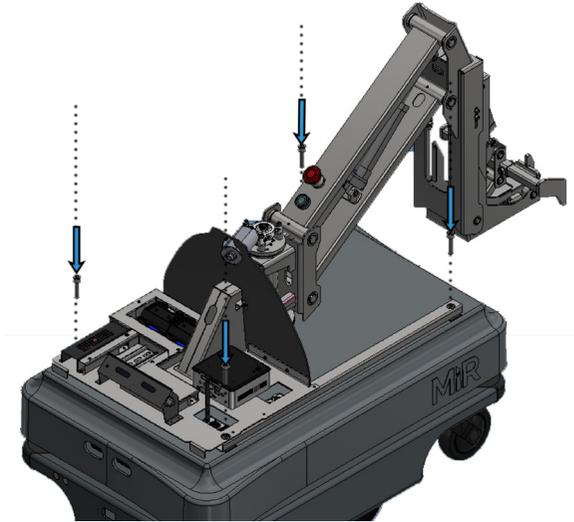
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Remove the hook cover and lift the hook onto the robot fitting the frame holes above the four mooring holes on the robot.



③

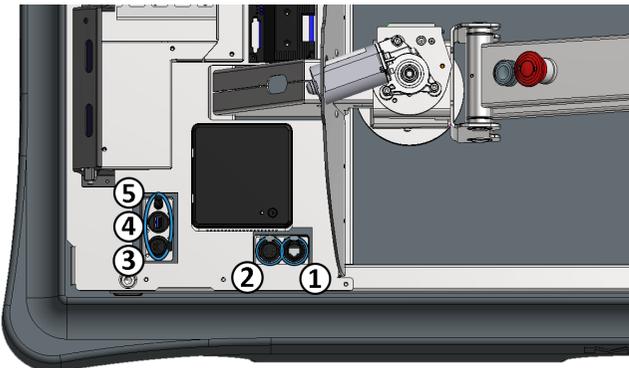
Mount the frame with the 4 bolts. Tighten the bolts to a torque of 47 [Nm] / [34.5 ft-lb].



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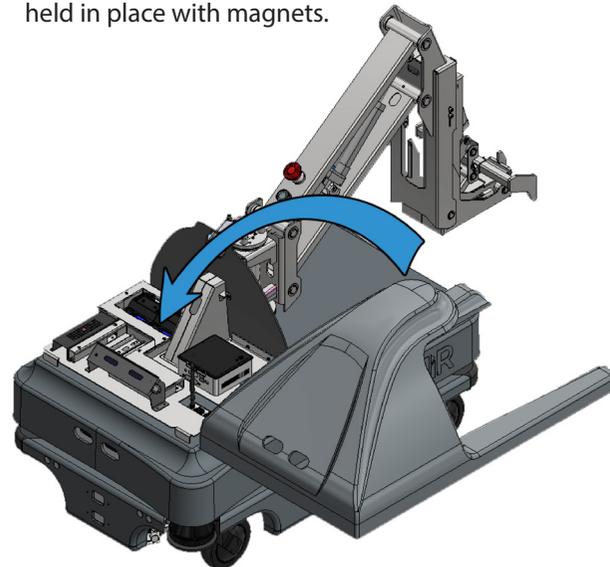
Connect cables and mount the antenna:

1. Network cable (from robot to hook PC)
2. Application hardware cable
3. Emergency stop cable
4. USB cable for top camera
5. Antenna connector

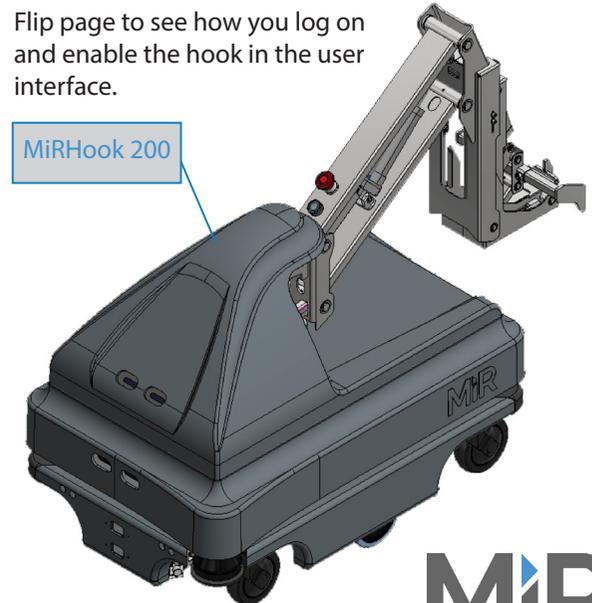
Place the cover on top of the hook frame. The cover is held in place with magnets.

MiRHook™ 200 Connecting: Robot Interface 2.0

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Connect to WiFi:

Turn on the robot. On a PC or tablet, go to the WiFi menu, find the name of your robot and connect to it.

Open robot user interface:

Open a browser and go to mir.com. Log in with username: **distributor** and password: **distributor**.

Enable Hook feature:

Navigate to **Features** (System > Settings > Features) and set **Hook** to True.

④

Set up hook with carts:

In the **main** menu, a new **Hook** icon appears. This is where all settings to prepare the robot for automatic pick up and delivery of carts are made.
